Weekly 'Hands On' Activities

Tuesday Community Growing – 10am-3pm

A varied mix of horticultural activities reflecting the changing seasons. Local and international volunteers share a tea-break at 11am and a vegetarian, cooked lunch from 1-2pm. We enjoy a social, cultural exchange... then everyone mucks in with the washing-up!

Wednesday Chicken Care – 2pm-5pm

Egg collecting, feeding, watering, and mucking out.

Thursday Picking & Packing – 10am-3pm

This is our busiest day of the week; harvest day! Lots of hands make light work as we pick, weigh, portion, and pack the veg boxes as a team.

Friday Drivers

We have a couple of highly dedicated volunteers who deliver our veg boxes across Penwith on Fridays and we would welcome two more to cover occasional holidays, must be aged 25+.

Sunday Tree Care – 2pm

Meet our volunteer-led group of practical climate activists and quiet conservationists at 2pm weekly to help plant, mulch and propagate trees. We have planted hundreds of trees here every winter and continue to care for them beautifully.

Farm Shop

Our shop is open 10am-5pm Monday-Saturday, run by a rota of volunteers, selling local and organic goods both from our farm and from other ethical suppliers. Full training is given and it's a nice sociable indoor role. Get in touch if you have a morning or afternoon to spare.

Hospitality Angels

We welcome people who can cook, bake, pour tea to join us for social refreshments and help to make our local and international volunteers welcome, as well as helping on special event days.
