1 St Just Market

Held every Saturday in the WI Hall - Bosavern Community Farm produce, fresh fish, and handmade goods.

2 McFaddens Butchers

Local butchers known for quality meats from their family farm and a fine pastry.

3 Stones Fruit & Veg

Grocer selling a wide range of fresh fruit and vegetables from local growers.

A fantastic selection of local food and drink products.

A traditional family butcher providing organic meat including home grown stock.

3 The Phoenix Cafe

Fully gluten-free café serving homemade pasties (meat from Vivian Olds) and great cakes.

4 The Commercial Hotel

Serving traditional Cornish dishes with Local Ales and Cape Cornwall Rum!

5 The Kings Arms

Serving Vivian Olds sausages and fresh local fish.

6 The Square


Freshly prepared food to take away. Produce from Whistle Hill Dairy and Paul's Bread.
